Instructions for designers

Design possibilities and restrictions

When creating a design you should have in mind from the beginning for which boat model are you aiming.

These parameters will inform what is available and what is permitted:

1. Model - Know the model you're aiming for and its shape


2. Construction SCS

- . a) Up to 4 colors.
- . b) Clear carbon is not available.
- c) Printed vinyl, only available in deck. The areas available are defined in one of the attachments.

3. What to consider when ordering a design:

- . a) What model to design for;
- b) Choose colors from the available palette as listed on the below template;

- . c) Consider colors for stickers, where available;
- d) The Cockpit can only have one color. Designs not available in this area;
- e) Avoid metallic colors. Avoid gradients unless it will be printed vinyl and available only if apply in the deck;
- f) The first 90 cm and the last 90 can only have one color, as in the picture:

Info for Customers how to order a boat

Every boat design should respect the following rules:

- The first 90 cm and the last 90 cm should be of a single color;
- Images, illustrations, patterns or other detailed features are only available on the deck;
- Shapes on the hull must be at least 3 cm wide;
- You be asked to provide the vector files like EPS or AI, and image JPG with colors,

These are the same file you need to upload in the nelo area when you ordering the new boat.

Designs with complex Paintings and low resistance Varnish

- paintings on the hull can't be repaired, so the best option is always to have the hull in gel coat;
- paintings only in the deck;
- more problems with temperatures (print through);
- less warranty time;

- not choosing the colors that are in our GelCoat option list makes it very hard to repair the boat in the future.

TAKE EXTRA CARE OF YOUR BOAT:

- Don't leave in the sun for long periods of time;
- Don't apply solvents;
- Avoid contact with abrasives;
- Have extra care when handling not to bump it hard;
- Always dry it prior to storage;
- Use a cover whenever possible;
- Do not tie it down too tight.
